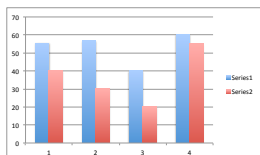


E4: PAIR PRESENTATION : Take a Survey

TIME: 5 Minutes

Group Members: Materials: Must have a Powerpoint & examples of your survey filled out



* NO SKIN WHITENING

You and your partner need to conduct a survey of students at Assumption University. You both need to create a survey with relevant questions and get answers from your classmates (IN OTHER CLASSES—not from this section). You may do the survey online (using google docs) or you may distribute a paper survey. However, regardless of the method you decide to use, you must still present me with examples of your survey filled out.



DO:

- * say your name very clearly including your nickname
- * establish eye contact with the entire classroom--not just the teacher
- * use proper, professional language

You need to have:
1. Proper introduction.
2. PowerPoint
3. Proper Conclusion

DO NOT

- * Read from your slides. Nobody wants to see you embarrass yourself reading.
- * Come to class unprepared. If you do not have a PowerPoint, you will fail.
- * Use material that is not yours.



Example of some topics: *Smokers vs non-smokers, Android vs. iOS, exercise habits, brand loyalty, dog owners vs cat owners, favourite non-school activities, favourite restaurant chain, etc.* You can also use trend questions: *Are GPAs generally going up or down from semester to semester? Are senior students more confident than first year students? etc.*

THIS IS A PAIR PRESENTATION:

Be prepared for Emergencies:

If one of the members of your pair has an emergency or does not show up, **be prepared to present that person's part.** The missing or absent member will receive a failing grade for not showing up, but if you are not able to do their part, your marks will also be reduced. There will be no delays or rescheduling.

There will be no late assignments and no excuses:

If you are required to present on a certain day, you had better be prepared to present. Check and double-check your PowerPoint before presenting. There is no excuse for a missing or corrupt file on the day of presenting. Have a backup plan or a backup file. I will not accept technical delays nor delays due to personal issues between group members. Treat your assignments as professional deadlines. Be on time, with no excuses.

YOU MUST HAVE:

Your introduction should tell the audience the following

- * student name
- * student ID
- * Subject, and have a brief overview of the material, including who will cover each part.
- * **EXPLAIN WHY YOU CHOSE THE TYPE OF CHART USED (pie, line, graph, etc.)**
- * **PowerPoint & Example Survey (printed survey)**

Your conclusion should tell the audience the following:

- * A brief overview of major highlights of your presentation
- * A proper recommendation or wrap-up of the subject

Finally:

This is a professional environment, and you should dress and behave accordingly. Every one of you knows the rules of dress and behaviour expected of you by the University, and you should abide. Language that is deemed offensive to others based on religion, gender, nationality, political viewpoint, sexual orientation or ethnic background will not be permitted. Treat each person with respect.
