Part 2a: Attendance & Behavior

Accepted Absences	Non Excused Absences (marks will be reduced) - 5 marks for each absence.
Sick with doctor's excuse or other evidence accepted by Ajarn Dan.	Visits to the registrar office for class signups
Pre-approved absence from Ajarn Dan	Ethics class
School or faculty activity that has been cleared through the IELE office. You must have a letter with your name on it and faculty leader's signature and contact information.	Other subject makeup classes
Family emergency	3 late attendance = 1 absence
Unforeseen accidents	Family obligations: weddings, vacations, personal work involvement

Part 2b: Personal Day

Every student will be allowed **1 personal day (PD)**. However, personal days cannot be used for skipping presentations or dictations. In order to make those up if they are available, you will need unofficial clinic slip or letter from your faculty. Personal days are for regular days only.

- * Be prepared. There will be no late assignments accepted. If your team member(s) are absent, you will still be expected to do your part of the assignment.

PRESENTATION BREAKOUT



1. Presentation 1:

Each group will be given a article to read and examine. There will be five questions posed for each article, and group members must carefully read the instructions and the story provided. The content score will be based on the student's understanding.

Marks: In most cases, the entire group will be given the same presentation marks. So, you're only as strong as your weakest member! This is worth 10 marks.

2. Presentation 2:

Each pair will be assigned a data graph to examine and explain. Students are expected to determine the underlying reasons for why the data appears the way it does. Students must clearly explain the information and provide insight based on their research of the topic.

Marks: In most cases, both members will be given the same score. So, you're only as strong as your weakest presenter! This is worth 20 marks.

3. Presentation 3:

Each student will be given a choice of topics to chose from, and must do a short argumentative/persuasive presentation of their opinions on the topic. Students may agree or disagree with the topic.


Marks: This is worth 30 marks.



Professionalism marks are not automatic. You must earn them.



Avoid simple mark reductions. Don't play on your cellphone during lectures. This is an automatic 2-mark reduction each time.



Marks will also be reduced if you are using Listening & Speaking time to prepare for other subjects, including the academic English subject.



Be on time to class. Late attendance can cost you 1 to 2 marks, while absences are automatically 5 marks reduced.
